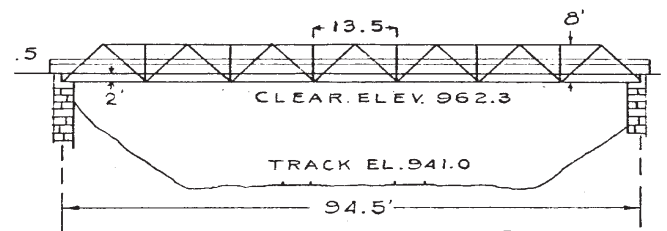
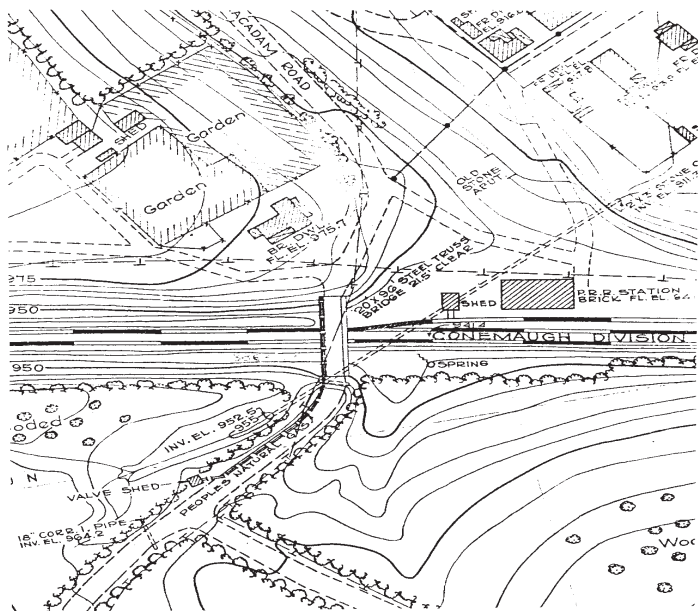


# WEST PENN TRAIL at LIVERMORE HIGHWAY BRIDGE

This highway bridge, over the West Penn Railroad tracks, carried traffic to Livermore until the town had to be abandoned (dismantled) in 1952, when the gates were closed on the Conemaugh Dam. When the town ceased to exist, the need for this bridge ended, also.
