This bridge was removed in 1952 just before the gates were closed on the Conemaugh Dam. The bridge had been built in 1907 to serve just one place – the Nesbit farm, located at the end of the State road. The farm had to be abandoned in 1952, for it would be underwater in the flood-control reservoir.

This cut, made in 1903 for relocation of the railroad, destroyed a hilltop pond that had fed water to a track-side tank at the watering station marked "Bow" on the map
