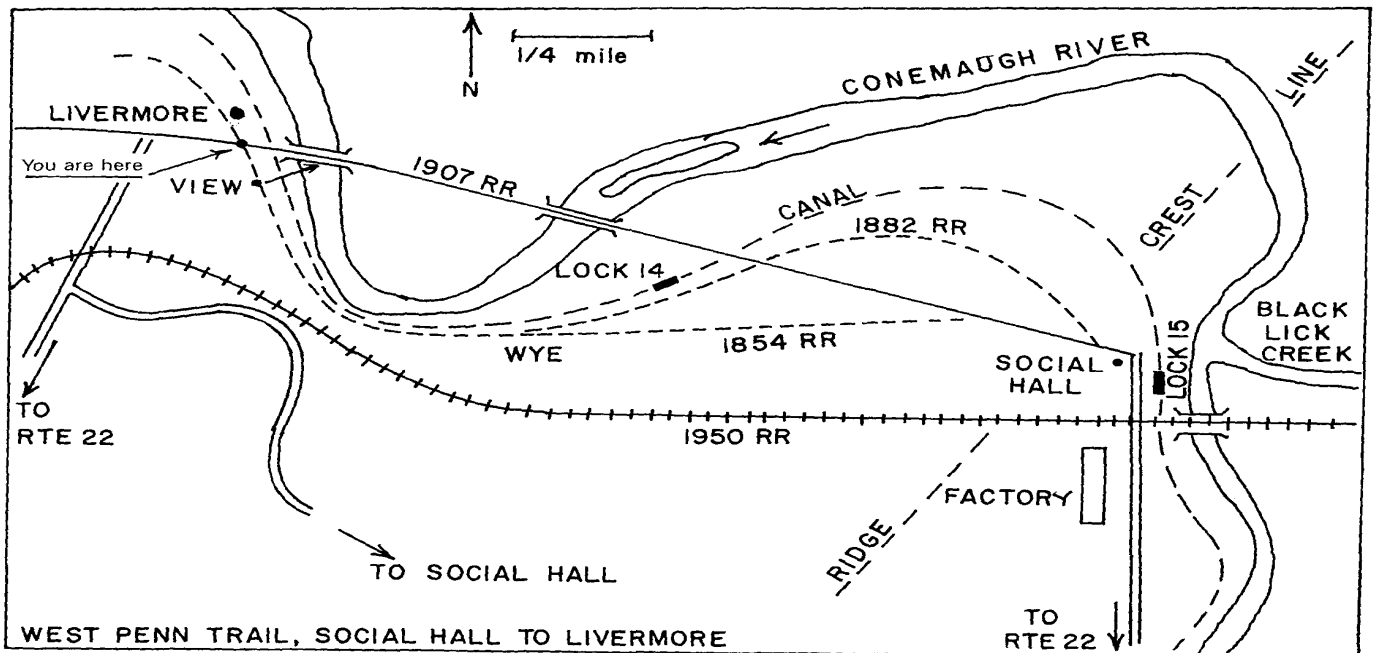


WEST PENN TRAIL at LIVERMORE STATION



Before the West Penn Railroad was relocated, in 1907, onto the straight line followed today by the trail, tracks ran parallel to the river and parallel to the canal that was still in use, in 1864, when the first train ran from Blairsville to Saltsburg.

After 1907, trains stopped here, at the new trackside station for Livermore. The original (1864) station was north of here, just before the track bed passes through a deep cut and then onto a causeway that now ends at a bridge abutment on the bank of the river.
